



NEW 332 AREA CODE FOR NEW YORK CITY (212/646/917 AREA)

To ensure a continuing supply of telephone numbers, a new 332 area code was approved by the New York State Public Service Commission. The 332 area code will be added to the same geographic area in New York that is served by the 212, 646, and 917 area codes. This overlay will supplement the existing area codes, and does not require customers to change their current area codes.

When the overlay begins

Beginning June 10, 2017, new telephone lines or services may be assigned numbers using the new 332 area code.

What remains the same

- Your telephone number, including current area code, will not change.
- The price of a call, coverage area, or other rates and services will not change due to the overlay.
- Local calling areas will remain the same.
- You will continue to dial 1+ area code + telephone number for all long distance calls.
- You can still dial just three digits to reach 911.
- If 211, 311, 411, 511, 611, 711 or 811 are currently available in your community you will still dial these codes with just three digits.

What you need to do

Since this coverage area already employs a ten-digit dialing protocol, there will be no change in the way that you dial-out.
